FAQ - Frequently Asked Questions

- 0. Will this camp be postponed because of the Coronavirus? As of right now we hope to do the camps in the dates scheduled, however if necessary, we will postpone the camp depending on what the circumstances are.
- 1. Why are we doing this camp? We are doing this camp mainly for all high school students (boys and girls) that cannot afford the expensive camps and want to be exposed to soccer college recruiters.
- 2. How much does this college camp cost? The cost is \$20 per player for this 1-day camp, the payment must be done online (www.houstonfutbol.com).
- 3. **How do I apply?** You must complete the online application (<u>www.houstonfutbol.com</u>) as soon as possible since only 120 players will be selected to attend this camp.
- 4. When will the final list of players selected be announced? The final list of players will be announced approximately one week before the camp. It will be published in the official website.
- 5. **What should I bring?** Please bring the following: white socks, black shorts, all-white jersey, grass soccer shoes, hard surface running shoes, own water, own soccer ball and snacks. There will be a concession stand so bring some money and Dairy Queens is also within walking distance.
- 6. What is the schedule of events like? The official schedule of events is posted on the website.
- 7. What college coaches will be in attendance? The final list of college coaches will be announced approximately 3 days before the camp.
- 8. Will pro team scouts be in attendance? Yes, they be there, they are coming from Mexico and the USA to look for talent. The final list of coaches will be listed approximately 3 days before the camp.
